SOMMELIER RECOMMENDATIONS

2023 English Rosé, Folc

A vibrant and elegant wine with a delicate blush color and a bouquet of fresh, floral aromas. It features notes of wild strawberries, raspberries, and a hint of citrus zest, complemented by subtle floral undertones. On the palate, it is crisp and lively with balanced acidity, finishing clean and dry. Ideal food pairings include grilled prawns with lemon, fresh oysters, seared scallops, or goat cheese.

2022 Chardonnay, La Crema

This Sonoma Coast Chardonnay is a rich and complex wine that beautifully showcases the character of Sonoma Coast. With its bright golden color and aromas of ripe pear, green apple, vanilla, and a hint of oak, this wine is a masterpiece of balance and complexity. On the palate, the flavors are lush and buttery, with a creaminess that lingers long after the last sip. The finish is dry and refreshing with a layer of minerality that adds depth and complexity. This chardonnay pairs perfectly with a wide range of foods, including seafood, shellfish, roasted chicken, and creamy pasta dishes.

2022 Vouvray “Les Coteaux Tufiers” Boutinot

A charming expression of Chenin Blanc from the Loire Valley. It exhibits a pale straw color with green hints, and an aromatic nose of honeysuckle, acacia, green apple, pear, and quince. On the palate, it is medium-bodied and well-balanced, with fresh acidity and a touch of sweetness. Ideal food pairings include grilled seafood, particularly scallops, roasted chicken, and creamy cheeses. It also complements dishes with light sauces, such as salmon pasta or vegetable risotto. The wine's vibrant character enhances these flavors, making it a versatile choice for various meals.

2009 Château Haut-Batailley

Deep garnet color and complex aromas of blackcurrant, blackberry, and plum, with cedar, tobacco, and graphite notes. On the palate, it is full-bodied and well-structured, with finely integrated tannins and balanced acidity, offering layers of dark fruit flavors, oak, leather, and earthy undertones. Ideal food pairings include beef and lamb. It also complements aged cheeses like Comté. This wine's robust and refined character makes it perfect for special occasions.

2020 Carmenere “Family Vintage” Tres Palacios

A standout Chilean red wine, notable for its deep ruby color and expressive bouquet. Aromas of ripe blackberries, plums, and black cherries meld with hints of black pepper, tobacco, and dark chocolate. On the palate, it is full-bodied with smooth tannins and a balanced acidity, delivering flavors of dark fruit, spices, and a touch of oak. Ideal pairings include lamb and cheeseburger. It also complements our cheese board well.
