SOMMELIER RECOMMENDATIONS

2023 La Crema, Chardonnay

A rich and complex wine that beautifully showcases the character of Sonoma Coast. With its bright golden color and aromas of ripe pear, green apple, vanilla, and a hint of oak, this wine is a masterpiece of balance and complexity. On the palate, the flavors are lush and buttery, with a creaminess that lingers long after the last sip. The finish is dry and refreshing with a layer of minerality that adds depth and complexity. This chardonnay pairs perfectly with a wide range of foods, including seafood, shellfish, chicken, and creamy pasta dishes.

2010 Domaine Loïc Mahé, Savennieres “Équilibre”

Loïc Mahé, a renowned organic winemaker, is known for crafting pure and expressive Savennières wines. The 2010 Savennières 'Équilibre' offers rich aromas of ripe apple, quince, and white flowers, with hints of honey, almond, and elegant minerality. The palate is vibrant and well-balanced, with bright acidity and a long, saline finish.

Crisp and elegant white Burgundy. It offers fresh citrus and green apple flavors, with hints of white flowers and a touch of minerality. Smooth and balanced, with a refreshing finish, it pairs wonderfully with seafood, white meats, or creamy cheeses. A fine example of Burgundy's finesse in white wines.

2020 Carmenere “Family Vintage” Tres Palacios

A standout Chilean red wine, notable for its deep ruby color and expressive bouquet. Aromas of ripe blackberries, plums, and black cherries meld with hints of black pepper, tobacco, and dark chocolate. On the palate, it is full-bodied with smooth tannins and a balanced acidity, delivering flavors of dark fruit, spices, and a touch of oak. Ideal pairings include lamb and cheeseburger. It also complements our cheese board well.
